“Prophylactic bilateral internal iliac artery catheterisation for control of haemorrhage during elective caesarean section for grade 4 anterior placenta previa: A series of 5 cases”

“Systematic reviews and meta-analyses”

Each speaker was allocated 10 minutes for their presentation with a further 5 minutes for questions. All five presentations were of a high standard and worthy of the prize. However, after much discussion, it was agreed that the first prize of £250 would be awarded to Dr Sen. The runner-up prize of £100 (donated from the section's funds) was awarded to Dr Lalkhen. Both prize winners will give their presentations at the Joint Meeting with the Yorkshire Society of Anaesthetists on Saturday 21st April 2007.

The president thanked the remaining presenters for their contribution in making the evening a success with nearly 80 members and guests in attendance. He also announced that each person would receive a certificate to mark the occasion.

After the meeting an informal Buffet supper was held at MANDEC in honour of the presenters.
