Dr K Duxbury	"How well can we estimate bio-available testosterone?"
Mrs M Sutherland	"The Molecular Biology of type 3 von Willebrand Disease (VWD)"
Dr S Thomas	"Lack of vision; loss of sight. Consequences of mandatory HTLV screening in corneal transplantation"

Each speaker was given ten minutes for their presentation and a further five minutes for discussion and questions from the judges and the audience.

The Judges (Drs A M Kelly, H Panigrahi, A M Will and G E Wilson) along with members and guests in the audience listened attentively to three very interesting lectures.

After much deliberation it was agreed to award the 2006/2007 Trainees' Prize of a £150 cheque and medal to Dr S Thomas.

The President, on behalf of the judges, bestowed his commiserations to the other two presenters.

Following the meeting, a dinner was held in honour of the presenters, at the Moso Moso Thai Restaurant on Oxford Road which brought the evening to a pleasant close.
