Contemporary adjuvant therapy - Cidofovir”**

K LAMMIN

**“Nutrition in patients with a fractured neck of femur”**

K J DALY

**“Does paradoxical cerebral embolism during hip surgery matter?”**

The results were tallied at the end of the meeting and compared with the adjudicating panel (Section of Surgery Council).

Mr Mughal thanked all four presenters for the quality and high standards of their presentations and thanked the audience for their participation. He then announced that the winner would be revealed at the dinner following the meeting, which would be held in Chancellors Restaurant.
