THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES APPLY TO ALL SUBMISSIONS

- Abstracts should present novel findings or new interpretations of existing data. They should include brief details of the rationale for the research and the methods used, including the statistical approach. Ideally the major findings should be stated. Any references necessary for an understanding of the work should be included, either in the body of the text or at the end.
- Submissions are accepted on the understanding that the work concerned has been performed with the permission of any relevant ethical or legislative body.
- All sources of financial sponsorship of the study should be stated clearly at the end of the abstract
- Authors submitting more than one abstract on a single topic (or related topics) may have their abstracts returned to them, together with a request that they resubmit the material as a single abstract.
- Communication regarding the abstract will only be made to the presenting (or corresponding) author
- All training grade psychiatrists, SAS doctors and consultants within 2 years appointment are eligible to apply, ie appointed after February 2006.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSTRACT PREPARATION

1. Please consult the GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS overleaf before preparing your abstract.
2. Abstracts must be typed on plain white A4 paper.
3. Type the title, then type name(s) in bold lettering on the next line, in the following format: **Nutt DJ, Glue P, Wilson SW**. The name of the presenting author should be underlined. Continue address after names. Do not exceed 3 lines in total for names and addresses and use abbreviations where possible. Leave a blank line before commencing text. Do not centre text.
4. Text should be single-spaced. Use no smaller than a 10pt font and a laser printer if possible. The abstract should be a maximum of two sides of A4 paper.
5. Authors are encouraged to include tables or figures within the text, as appropriate.
6. Use only standard abbreviations for units of measure. If other abbreviations are used, spell out in full at first mention and put abbreviations in parentheses following this.
7. Please include references within the text as follows: First name and et al where more than two authors, year, Journal, volume, pages.
8. Send your abstract to the Manchester Medical Society Office by mail, email or fax, as detailed overleaf.
