Directions to North Manchester General:

North Manchester General Hospital is located in the Crumpsall area of North Manchester. For those coming by car and using SATNAV the postcode is M8 5RB and the hospital is located on Delaunays Road.

If driving from Merseyside or West Yorkshire follow the M62 and then the M60 clockwise exiting at Junction 20. On coming off the motorway turn right onto the A664 Rochdale Road travelling towards the city centre. Continue along Rochdale Road until you pass a fire station on your left. Shortly afterwards there is a right fork in the road signposted to North Manchester General Hospital. Follow this road for around a mile and a half when the hospital is to be found on the left.

If driving from South Manchester and Cheshire I would strongly advise that if you join the M60 from the M56 then you follow the motorway anticlockwise as this is a less busy section in the morning, exiting at junction 19 travelling along the A576 towards Manchester. North Manchester General is signposted as a left turn down either Blackley New Road or Crumpsall Lane after a mile or so.

If travelling by public transport, North Manchester is roughly a ten minute walk from the Crumpsall stop on the Metrolink line to Bury.

The Postgraduate Centre is located in a building that looks like an old house at the front of the hospital. Like many hospitals these days parking can be a problem so you should arrive in good time. However, in common with most hospitals, there is a charge for parking. Clamps are purported to exist, and whilst I have never seen them, you would be taking a chance in not paying.
