The ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING of the Manchester Medical Society was held on **Wednesday 27th October 2010** at 5.30 pm in the Flowers Theatre, Chancellors Conference Centre, Moseley Road, Fallowfield.

The Minutes of the Annual General Meeting held on the 21st October 2009 was agreed.

Annual Report & Accounts

The Annual Report and Accounts for the Session 2009/2010 had been circulated previously. The Chairman, Dr Ray McMahon, reported that last session brought an end to the Society's 175th anniversary celebrations. The largest attended meeting was the first Manchester Medical Careers Fair on the 17th March 2010 which was organised jointly with the University of Manchester Medical School and the Manchester Medical Careers Society. Over 800 individuals turned up at University Place and joined in a variety of exercises. The Society continues to thrive, however, expenditure this year has exceeded income, and therefore Council seek approval to increase the annual subscription slightly.

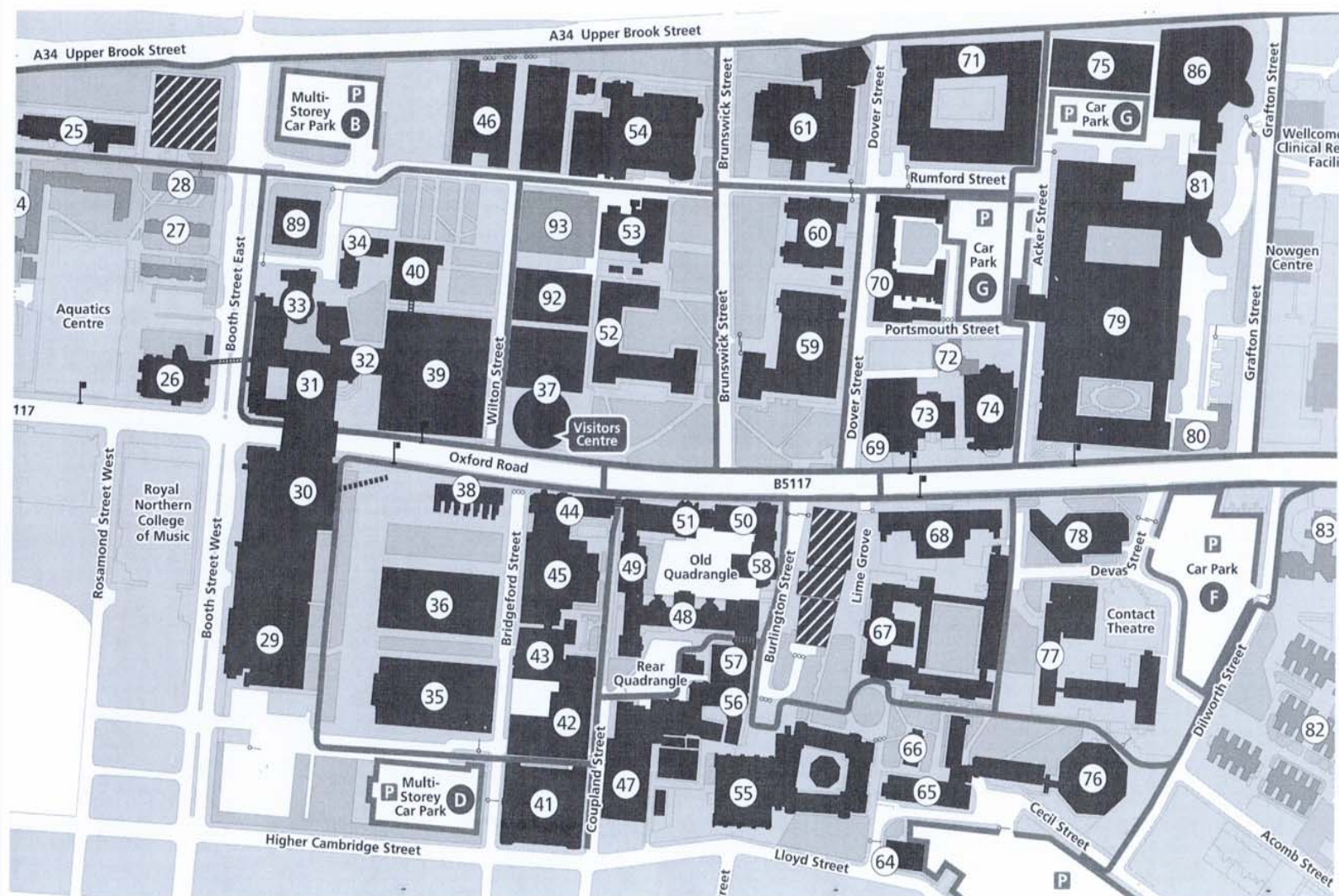
Special thanks were made to Professor Ian Isherwood who had decided to stand down as Honorary Librarian after holding this post for many years.
